Our Recycling Drop-off Center is located at 995 Coolidge (between 14 & 15 Mile Roads) in Troy. **Please bring a driver's license to verify residency.**

- When you purchase a new television, try to get the seller to take your old one.
- Consider donating the old TV to a charity or low income family.
