Stay Warm & Energy Efficient This Winter!

This cold winter weather calls for some warm measures. Here are some tips to stay warm this winter while keeping your energy bills down.

Check your Furnace Filters

Winter cleaning! Remember to clean or replace your furnace filters once a month during the cold season. This will help improve airflow and help reduce energy bills.

Run Fans in Reverse

Hot air rises. To help circulate the warm air, try running ceiling fans in the opposite direction. Fans produce cold air when they run counter-clockwise, however, a clockwise rotation however will help distribute the heat. Most fans have a button to reverse the direction.

Block Drafts

Is it drafty in here? Drafts can waste from 5-30% of your energy usage! The fastest way to block drafts entering your home from the doors is to use a draft snake. This can be as simple as rolling up a bath towel or making one yourself by using rice or sand as the fill.

Insulate Your Windows

Layer up! You can keep in the heat with a fairly low cost by easily applying insulation film on your windows. Don't worry, insulation film is transparent, so it won't change the aesthetics of your windows.

Insulate Your Pipes

Put a sweater over your hot water pipes. Insulating hot water pipes will help bring down your energy bills and decrease the chance of pipes freezing. Place pre-slit pipe foam from hardware stores over any warm pipes and fasten in place with zip ties or duct tape.
