Thank you for making last month's Earth Day a wonderful celebration! SOCRRA opened its doors to the community during the week long event, where students, adults, and families took part in:

- A tour of the material recovery facility, to see first hand where all of the recyclables are sorted and processed.
- A hands-on material sorting line where they learned what items were and were not recyclable.
- A lesson on how to upcycle plastic water bottles by turning them into colorful arts and crafts, and
- A complimentary dinner served by SOCRRA staff.



There were a total of 340 people who visited the facility and took part in the festivities. Worldwide, over a billion people in 192 countries took part in this global event. In the State, the Department of Environmental Quality held their annual Earth Day poster contest.
