With the holiday season upon us, many recyclers have questions about items that are more common during this time of year. Here is a quick cheat sheet of recyclables to keep in mind this year:



Aluminum Trays  
(emptied and rinsed)



Plastic packaging  
(any plastic containers)



Cardboard boxes  
(flattened & cut to size)



Boxboard  
Gift boxes and food packaging



Holiday greeting cards  
(including photo cards)



Wrapping paper, tissue paper, paper gift bags & paper tubes



Packaging foam such as molded forms and shapes—DROP-OFF ONLY

## Foam Recycling Now Available at Drop-off Center



Do these items look familiar? Many people commonly refer to these items as “Styrofoam”, which is a type of **polystyrene foam** (similar to how many people refer to tissues as Kleenex, a brand name tissue product).

Beginning December 1, 2014, SOCRRA now accepts **polystyrene foam** at the Recycling Drop-off Center. You can now drop off the following foam items:

- ⇒ Cups
- ⇒ Takeout containers
- ⇒ Egg cartons
- ⇒ Meat trays
- ⇒ Food trays/lunch trays
- ⇒ Packaging foam such as molded forms and shapes (No packaging peanuts please)

For successful foam recycling, please follow these guidelines:

- ⇒ Make sure all items are clean and rinsed to remove food remnants.
- ⇒ Please do not place foam items in your curbside bin. This program is available at our drop-off only.
