No More Appointments for Hazardous Waste Drop-off

As of September 1, 2015, appointments are no longer required to access SOCRRA's Household Hazardous Waste and Electronic Drop-off Programs. In the past appointments have served a purpose to ensure the efficient operation of the program, but the program has now evolved to be able to provide this service in an even more convenient manner for users to safely dispose of unwanted hazardous materials from the home.

This service is available ONLY to residents of our 12 SOCRRA communities as well as residents of Bingham Farms, City of Bloomfield Hills (not the Township), and City of Rochester (Rochester residents must first purchase a voucher from their city office). Residency will be verified by the attendant on site.

The program operates Monday—Friday from 8:00 am—3:30 pm (until 5:30 on Wednesdays only) and Saturday from 8:00 am—2:00 pm. The program location remains at the same address: 995 Coolidge (between 14 Mile and Maple).

Medical Items

- Any Old Medication (prescription or non). Empty into unmarked zip top baggie
- Syringes/Needles in rigid plastic or metal container

Miscellaneous

- Rechargeable Batteries
- Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFLs)
- Cooking Oil
- 4 ft and 8 ft Fluorescent Tubes

NOT ACCEPTED: Unlabeled waste or containers with unknown contents—Radioactive materials—Explosives—waste from clean up or spills—Hazardous Waste generated by a business or industry.
