

SOCRRA Electronics Recycling Guide

Electronics can be brought to SOCRRA for recycling and safe disposal free of charge.

This service is available to residents and business of SOCRRA's 12 member communities and residents ONLY of Bingham Farms, City of Bloomfield Hills (not the Township), and Rochester (Rochester residents must purchase a voucher from their city office).

Don't Forget:

- Proof of residency required. Businesses must provide a business card or letterhead.
- Only items listed will be accepted
- Residents must remove sensitive or personal information from hard drives, etc.



Did the Holidays Bring You New Gadgets? *Recycle the old ones!*

December usually brings gifts of the latest electronic technology and by January our once-cherished gadgets end up in the basement, garage or worse, the trash can. Due to Americans' obsession with technology e-waste or electronic waste, like computers, cell phones and gaming systems, electronics have become one of the fastest growing material filling up landfills, according to the Environmental Protection Agency. Electronics contain harmful contaminants such as lead, cadmium, beryllium or brominated flame retardants which if landfilled or incinerated cause environmental harm.

SOCRRA supports proper disposal and recycling of e-waste by providing a drop-off program for electronics six days a week. This service is available only to residents and businesses in our 12 member communities, and residents only of Bingham Farms, City of Bloomfield (not the Township) and Rochester (Rochester residents must purchase a voucher from their city office). No appointment is necessary, however proof of residency or business location (business card or letterhead) is required. Don't let old electronics go to waste, and give them a second life!
